







Land arrivals from the Balkan route in Trieste (Italian-Slovenian border)

Single adult men

The majority come from Afghanistan (38%), of whom the vast majority (76%) choose to continue their journey to other countries. Second and third nationality of single adult men are Bangladesh (15%) and Pakistan (14%), 91% of whom declared Italy is their final destination.

An average of **20 new single** adult men were reached each day

Unaccompained Children (UAC)

UACs Afghanistan. Only 15 of the unaccompanied children encountered asked for support to enter the minor reception system in Trieste. The main declared destinations are Germany, Switzerland and France.

An average of **4 new UAC** were reached each day

40 Family Units

out of the total representing 184 individuals (including 85 children)

50% of the families come from **Turkey** and **Turkish Kurdistan**, 15% from **Afghanistan**. The families met this month also include 4 single-parent households, consisting of single mothers or fathers with children. Only 8% of the families expressed willingness to stay in Italy.

An average of 1 new family unit were reached every 3 days



The vast majority (71%) of single adult women come from **Nepal**, followed by **India** (10%). 74% said they were traveling to other countries, primarily Portugal, France and Spain. Worth noting is an **increasing trend** in the percentage of single women encountered.

An average of **3 new single adult**women was reached each day

This snapshot shows the numbers of new migrants arriving from the Balkan route encountered by International Rescue Committee Italy and Diaconia Valdese in Trieste central station area during the reporting period. The data was gathered through individual and group interviews with people reached to provide legal orientation and first aid. The monitoring activity is carried out during the entire daytime, and partially in the evening, of every day of the year, including weekends and holidays.
