







People arriving from the Balkan route in Trieste (Italian-Slovenian border)



## DEMOGRAPHICS OF PEOPLE REACHED | JULY 2024

Single adult men

58% out of the total

60% of single adult men declared they would continue their journey to other countries, while 27% said they would seek asylum in Trieste. The main countries of origin remain Afghanistan (56%), Pakistan (12%) and Bangladesh (10%).

An average of 28 new single adult men were reached every day

The main countries of origin of UACs are **Afghanistan** (69%), **Syria** (16%) and **Egypt** (11%). Only 12 UACs sought support to enter the reception circuit in Trieste. 81% reported being in transit, with main declared destinations Germany, Switzerland and France.

An average of 11 **new UAC** were reached every day




Family Units

out of the total representing **240** individuals (including **130** children)

65% of families are from **Turkish Kurdistan** and 14% from **Turkey**. In 59% of cases, families say they are traveling to other countries, mainly Germany, and in 39% of cases they choose not to share their destination.

An average of 1 new family unit was reached every day



49% of single adult women are from **Nepal**, 34% from **India**. 25% declared they intend to stop in Italy, none in Trieste. 51% declared to be in transit to reach other countries, mainly Spain and Portugal.

An average of 2 **new single adult women** was reached each day

This snapshot shows the numbers of new migrants arriving from the Balkan route encountered by International Rescue Committee Italy and Diaconia Valdese in Trieste central station area during the reporting period. The data was gathered through individual and group interviews with people reached to provide legal orientation and first aid.
