
Information Activities



- Informative sessions of legal content in Athens, Ioannina, Thessaloniki 14
- 63 Participants, beneficiaries of international protection, were informed about:
 - the right to family reunification.
 - access to socio-economic rights.
 - the right to obtain a long-term residence permit and the Greek citizenship.
 - the grounds of their rights in European and national legal texts.
 - the values of the European Union.

Findings from the feedback survey

Advocacy activities



6 meetings with local authorities and service providers in Athens, Ioannina and Thessaloniki for.

Upcoming activities:

- Roundtable with representatives of policy-making/implementing bodies and the civil society sector for identifying integration issues and coordinating actions to address them.
- Highlighting the challenges in relation to the access to social benefits.
- Formulating cooperation channels.
- Online conference with representatives of the Council of Europe and the civil society sector of other member states to exchange good practices on access to social rights such as housing.
